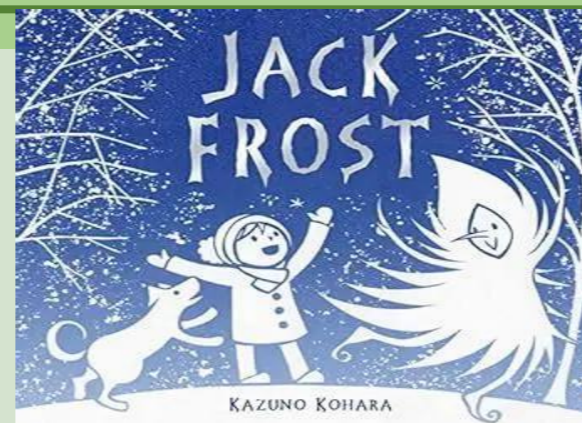
Little Wandle Phonics

In phonics this week we are learning the sounds for the phonemes oo / oo / ar / or. We will also be practising tricky words was, you, they. We will be reading sentences such as: I look at the moon.

Topic Activities

- 1) Sci - We will be listening to a seasons song and talking about what the trees look like in each season, creating our own seasons tree.
- 2) We will be thinking about colour that we use, how they are made and what colours we need for our artwork.
- 2) RE - We will be learning about 'World Religion Day'. We will be visitn the local church, creating religious symbols using playdough and designing a prayer mat.
- 4) PE - We will be continuing to practice being 'champion gymnast' and focusing on making low' shapes.

Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about the composition of numbers to 5.

We will be playing games involving items up to 5. This will include having 5 'ice gems', putting some in an 'igloo' and talking about how many could be under the igloo e.g., if 3 are outside the igloo then there must be 2 in the igloo.
