### Arctic

#### Little Wandle Phonics

In phonics this week we are learning the sounds for the phonemes ur / ow / oi / ear. We will also be practising tricky words 'they, into, my, by'. We will be reading sentences such as: We go to the shop in town.

#### Drawing Club

In our Drawing Club this week we are going to be watching 'Pingu - Hello Pingu'

We will be drawing a picture of Pingu and writing the sentence 'He is sad.' We will also be drawing Pingu's Igloo house. When writing we will be focussing on our letter formation as well as using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in the correct place.

#### Topic Activities

- 1) Sci - We will be conducting our own experiments looking at changes. Conduct your own experiment to see which biscuit lasts the longest when being dunked in warm water.
- 2) We will be creating our own binoculars to use during our 'Big Bird Watch'.
- 3) RE - We will be thinking about belonging and where we belong. We belong in our family, our school, our class and possibly some clubs such as football, gymnastics, etc. and the logos that show we belong in those groups, linking those to the religious symbols.
- 4) PE - We will be using the apparatus to help us become 'champion gymnasts'.

#### Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about weight and capacity.

Collect items from around the house. Put one in each hand and talk about which is the heaviest/lightest. How do you know?

Collect different sized spoons from around the house and a bowl or cup. How many small spoons does it take to fill your container? Which spoon is best? Why?

#### Outdoor Learning

During outdoor learning we will be taking part in the 'Big Bird Watch'. We will be using our binoculars to look for different birds and record what we see as well as creating a group bird feeder.
