Arctic

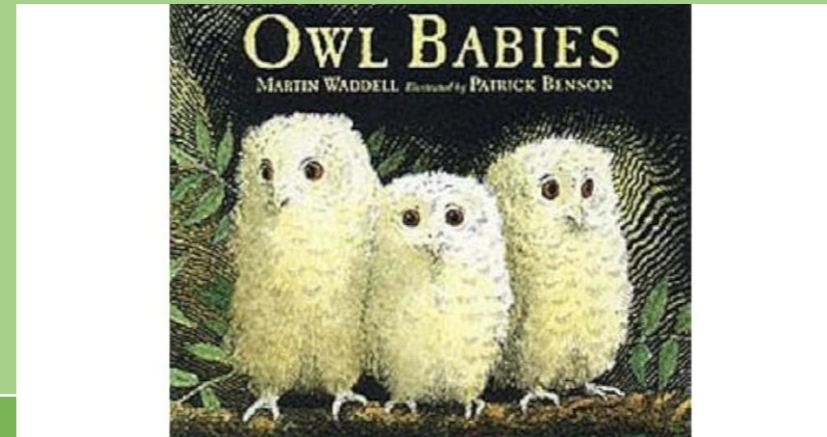
Little Wandle Phonics

In phonics this week we are learning about using digraphs in longer words. We will also be practising tricky words sure and pure. We will be reading sentences such as: The goat was in the farmyard.

Drawing Club

In our Drawing Club this week we are going to be focussing on the story 'Owl Babies'. We will be drawing one of the owls, the nest as the setting and, during our adventure time, we will invent a machine to find Mummy Owl.

We will be orally forming and writing our own sentences for our pictures. We will focus on putting finger spaces, capital letters and full stops, as well as making sure our letters are formed correctly.

Key Vocabulary: Nocturnal, swooping, Owlet, Habitat

Topic Activities

- 1) Sci - We will be focussing on colour and how colours are created. We will be conducting an experiment where we will observe what happens when we add vinegar to bicarb and how we can make it change colour.
- 2) We will be exploring the winter themed artwork of different artists and talking about what we like and dislike about them. We will then be creating our own Ted Harrison inspired art.
- 3) RE - We will be learning how people are welcomed into other faiths and how they are similar or different to what we found out last week.
- 4) PE - We will be using the apparatus to help us become 'champion gymnasts'. We will be thinking about how to create high and low balances.

Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about doubling.

Play the doubles game with 2 dice. Take it in turns to roll 2 dice. If you roll a double to get a counter (this could be a lego brick, dolls, etc.). The first person with 3 counters is the winner.
