How will my child access any online home/school learning you are providing?

Every children has a personal login ready to access Microsoft Teams. Attached to this letter is a set of instructions on how to access your child's Microsoft Teams account. Your child also has access to other Apps. These can be found at the top of your child's class page on Microsoft Teams. You can save their password and always be able to access their reading books and other accounts. This also includes access directly to the school webpage.
