During this half term holiday we would like you to read, read, read. Find all of your favourite books and read them in as many different places as you can. Read a book snuggled up in bed, on the sofa with a grown up, on a picnic blanket in the sunshine or in the car on the way for a day out maybe. While you are reading the books try to think about your favourite parts of the story, which characters are the funniest and why you like the book.

When you have finished your reading marathon have a think about which book is your favourite and why. We would then like you to complete a book review of your favourite.

Year 1: Complete a book review of your favourite using the template provided. Remember to include capital letters for names and places, fingers spaces and full stops if appropriate.

Challenge: Can you include an exclamation mark in your review?

Year 2: Complete a book review of your favourite book using the template provided. Remember to include capital letters (for names, places), fingers spaces, full stops, adjectives, adverbs, similes, exclamation marks and apostrophes if appropriate.

Challenge: Can you write both a positive and negative book review, one for a book you love and one for a book you dislike?

Please bring your book review into school on the first day back. Children who complete the half term challenge will receive a certificate at the start of next term to celebrate their hard work and effort at home!
