Kids Plant Trees

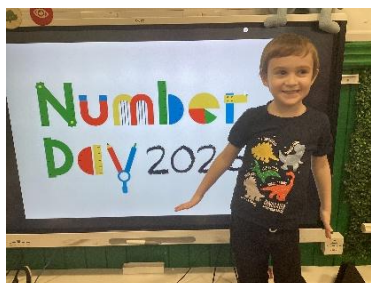
