We are really pleased to be welcoming Miss Clegg to our teaching team. Miss Clegg will be teaching Goldfinch class each day and is keen to get to know all of the children and their adults. We are also delighted to introduce our new member of staff Mrs Georgina Turner who is our new senior business assistant. She will be working in the school office and getting to know you all of the coming weeks. Mrs Edwards remains part of our team in a part-time role and will be working in school on a Thursday.

At the beginning of the year there are always new routines and new ways of working to get used to.

We want you to feel connected to your child's time in school and their learning. We can't wait to continue with the children's learning and build on the good work that you have been doing with them at home and that they have achieved in school and nursery. Please check information on the school website and in their book bags for home learning support. Whilst most information will be sent electronically there will be some times when a physical copy is more useful and we will send it out to you.



Our Parent Hub communication system is a great way for the school and your class teacher to keep in touch with you. The majority of our parents have the App on their phone; don't forget to log in to your child's new class to follow the posts relevant to your child. If you are new to our school please download the App. We are sure that you will like it.

### **Parent Pay**

We have an electronic system for any payments that are needed. You should have received all the information that you need to use this system. Any problems let us know.



### **Attendance At School**

Please make sure that your child is on time each day. The doors open at 8.40am and are closed at 8.50am prompt just prior to the close of register. If you arrive later than this then access is by the main office. If your child is absent for any reason please inform the school office before 10.00am on the day of absence with the given reason. The end of the school day is 15.10 and collection of all children is in the school playground. If you need an alternative arrangement please contact the school office. Thank you.



### **Morning Routines**

We encourage all our children to come in to school on their own every morning. We help our children learn their morning routines quickly and there are adults in school on hand to help them. We request that all parents stay in the playground after today, in order for them to build their own independence. Many thanks.

## Reading in School

We use Little Wandle Phonics in school. By ensuring high-quality phonics teaching we aim to:

- give all children a solid base upon which to build as they progress through school
- help children to develop the habit of reading widely and often, for both pleasure and information

This week we will be sending out reading books for you to read or share with your child. Real books are a hugely important part of children enjoying reading and the more stories you can have fun together sharing the better it is for their learning therefore every week your child will have a library session where they can also choose a library book.



## School Dinners

The cost of a school dinner is **£3.25** per meal for those children who pay for school meals in nursery.

School dinners continue to be free for all reception and Key Stage 1 children. If you think that you are entitled to free school meals please apply. This will enable you to have free school meals until your child has finished primary school.

For people who purchase additional nursery sessions the charge of £12.00 per session can also be paid using the account details above.



## **Breakfast and After School Club**

We have not put up the prices of any of our clubs to ensure that this remains an affordable service to those who wish to use it.

### **Breakfast Club**

As you may be aware we run a Breakfast Club that is open to all our school's children. The club starts at 7:30 am each day and will provide:

- Excellent support and child care by school trained staff
- A choice of breakfast; usually 4 types of cereal, fruit and toast with jams
- Drinks: Milk, cordial or water.
- A chance to play games and have fun with other children inside.

The cost of the club is **£4.50 a day (£4.00 without breakfast)** and runs from **7:30 to 8:40 each school day**. There is no need to book. If you have any queries please get in contact with the office or Mrs Jackson who is the Breakfast Club supervisor.

### **After School Club**

Killamarsh Infant and Nursery School and Killamarsh Junior School also run a shared After School Club, for the children from 4yrs to 11yrs attending our schools. The provision is for parents who wish to have more flexibility in their working arrangements, and who require high-quality, affordable child care. It is also for any child who wishes to attend to take part in the activities on offer. Sessions will run daily from 3.10pm – 5.30pm and costs are as follows:

<b>End of school – 5.00pm</b>	<b>5.00pm – 5.30pm</b>	<b>Every 10 mins there after (Late charge)</b>
<b>£7.50 (inc snack and drink)</b>	<b>£3.00</b>	<b>£6.00</b>
